Dear Caledonia-Mumford Parents and Guardians,

On Friday, Governor Cuomo permitted all schools in New York to reopen under certain conditions. First, all schools must have their Reopening Plans approved by the New York State Department of Health. Secondly, Districts must post on their website their respective plans and process for COVID-19 testing and Contact Tracing for sick or suspected sick individuals including students, faculty and staff. Thirdly, school districts must conduct three virtual discussion groups with parents and one virtual discussion with faculty and staff. Lastly, District's must post their Remote Virtual Learning Plans.

The District has completed or arranged for the following:

1. [Caledonia-Mumford District Reopening Plan](#) has been submitted to the New York State Department of Health and is awaiting approval.

The Faculty and Staff meeting will be on August 19, 2020 at 10:00 AM.
