### VACCINATION

At this time, the District will not be requiring students or staff to be vaccinated. The District will comply with the law. Achieving high levels of COVID-19 vaccination among eligible students as well as teachers, staff, and household members is one of the most critical strategies to help schools safely resume full operations.



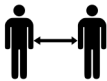
### MASKS

Masks are required to be worn by all individuals inside any school regardless of vaccination status.

Masks must be worn at indoor school events and while playing or attending athletic or any other indoor events.

Masks must completely cover your nose and mouth and fit snugly against your face.

Masks are not required outdoors. Unvaccinated people should wear a mask in crowded outdoor settings or when three feet social distancing is not possible. A mask will be provided to any student who does not have one or who needs a new one.



### SOCIAL DISTANCING

Maintain three feet of social distancing between students in classrooms and at indoor school locations, combined with mask wearing.



### SIGNAGE

Signage will be placed throughout district facilities reinforcing the main elements of our health and safety protocols.



### CAFETERIA & MEALS

Breakfast and lunch will be provided FREE of charge to ALL students. Maximize physical distance to the extent practicable when moving through the food service line and while eating. Remain masked until seated. Cafeterias will be cleaned immediately after use.; surfaces will be sanitized.



### TRANSPORTATION

Masks must always be worn on school buses by passengers, students and drivers. Masks will be provided to any student who does not have one. Capacity will be reduced where practicable.



### DAILY SCREENING

A daily screening is no longer necessary. However, students and staff will complete an attestation at the beginning of the school year and periodically throughout the school year. Any student, staff, or visitor must stay home if they are exhibiting symptoms.



### STAY HOME WHEN SICK

Students, teachers, and staff who have symptoms of infectious illness, influenza, or Covid-19 should stay home and be referred to their health care provider for testing/care.



### TECHNOLOGY

All technology devices will be sanitized and prepared for redistribution to students.

### SPORTS & ACTIVITIES

Masks are required to be worn by athletes and all individuals during INDOOR sporting events and in locker rooms. There is no limit to the number of spectators, unless at capacity, at sporting events. Indoor spectators must maintain three feet of distance if not from the same dwelling.



### HANDWASHING/HYGIENE

Students and staff will use every opportunity to properly wash their hands throughout the day. Staff will reinforce good hygiene etiquette and assist young children. Hand sanitizer will be available in all locations.



### FIELD TRIPS

As long as travel restrictions are not in place by government officials, the district may cautiously proceed with field trips as deemed appropriate. The district will fully disclose to families the risks associated with field trips (Covid transmission, non-refundable payments, etc.).



### CONTACT TRACING

The District will notify the state and local health department immediately upon being informed of any positive Covid-19 diagnostic test result by an individual within school facilities or on school grounds, including students, faculty, staff, and advisors of the District.



### CLEANING & SANITIZING

Cleaning and sanitizing will remain rigorous. School spaces and buses will be cleaned and sanitized using appropriate disinfectants. If someone in school tests positive for Covid, the classroom or space will be disinfected immediately.



### GUIDANCE & DATA

The district will consult with Livingston County Public Health, the agency that determines our CDC Zone designation as either low, moderate, substantial, or high transmission. A continuum of protocols will be implemented based on community transmission.



### VENTILATION

Improving ventilation is an important Covid-19 prevention that can reduce the number of virus particles in the air. CMCS uses the Novaerus system. When practicable, we will bring fresh outdoor air into the buildings by opening windows. During bus transportation, windows will be opened as appropriate.



### SCHOOL CLOSURE

Should a complete school closure be warranted as determined by the Livingston County Dept. of Health in consultation with the Superintendent of Schools, we will communicate the decision to the community as soon as possible.



### VISITORS

Visitors will be permitted on a limited basis and must wear masks inside any school building.



### COMMUNICATION
