Re: Reward School Designation



I am happy to report that the Caledonia-Mumford High School has been designated a Reward School by the New York State Education Department. NYSED has identified 155 Reward Schools (including 18 Charter Schools) in 89 school districts based on test and graduates results from the 2016-17 school year. During the 2016-17 school year, there were roughly 3300 schools in New York. In other words, this designation places Caledonia-Mumford High School in the top 5% of all schools in New York State.

Designated Reward Schools have the highest achievement in the State without significant gaps in student achievement between subgroups and have met all accountability status criteria. Furthermore, Reward Schools perform in the top 20% of schools for combined ELA and math Performance Index. Lastly, Reward Schools have a graduation rate above 80% (CM 91%) and a graduation rate with an advanced designation diploma status higher than 31% (CM 63%).
